



Enterprise Architect for Business Requirements Modelling Hands-On Workshop - 1 Day

This one day workshop is aimed at both business and system analysts who will be using the Sparx System's [Enterprise Architect](#) visual modelling tool to develop and/or document business requirements. The morning session concentrates on how to draw the various diagrams. The afternoon session looks in more detail at how to structure the model, create document or html-based reports and use the tool in general for both project and system requirements management. PLEASE NOTE: This workshop only teaches use of the tool. It does not teach the meaning of the model elements or diagrams or what modelling needs to be done.

Project Managers, Business Consultants, Business Analysts, Business Process Engineers, Requirements Gatherers, System Analysts, System Architects and System Designers.
